Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), Plantation Pipe Line Company ("Plantation") submits for filing the following tariffs, effective January 1, 2021:

- FERC No. 154.15.0, Rules and Regulations Tariff (cancels FERC No. 154.14.0)

Plantation is filing FERC No. 154.15.0 in order to revise its Customer Information Manual (CIM), Section 1, Section 3 and Section 4 effective January 1, 2021, as shown in FERC No. 154.15.0, Page 12, Note ①, and explained further below. All rates in FERC No. 154.15.0 are unchanged from the prior tariff.

Plantation is modifying Section 3 and Section 4 of its CIM to reflect the impact of EPA's regulatory streamlining efforts to be effective January 1, 2021. The most significant change is elimination of 40 CFR Part 80 which includes Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC). In response to the EPA streamlining Plantation has modified its Product Specifications which will simplify the minimum shipping requirements on its system. Plantation will maintain all current grade segregations year round. While streamlining may allow for commingling or rebranding of certain grades after the RVP control period ends on September 15, 2021 it will not allow the commingling or rebranding of products while in Plantation's possession at this time. We will continue to review these options for possible later implementation. The 2021 RVP Calendar has been appropriately modified. Additional changes to Plantation's product quality processes include; Jet Fuel minimum flash specification will be reduced from 108 degrees Fahrenheit to 105 degrees Fahrenheit and product laboratory analysis documents must be provided to Plantation prior to the batch entering the Plantation's system. Also, Plantation revised its contact list and phone numbers included in Section 1.

Additionally, Note ① on page 12 of FERC No. 154.12.0 are instructions on how to locate the Customer Information Manual on Plantation's website, as well as the revised effective date. The proposed version of Section 1, Section 3 and Section 4, which is included in this filing for easy reference, of the Customer Information Manual will be on Plantation's website under the heading "Proposed" until effective.
