Dear Secretary, Reese:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), Hiland Crude, LLC ("Hiland") submits for filing the following tariffs, effective July 1, 2025:

- FERC Tariff No. 2.22.0, Rules and Regulations, applying on the gathering / transportation of crude petroleum (cancels FERC 2.21.0); and
- FERC Tariff No. 4.19.0, Proportional Tariff applying on the gathering / transportation of crude petroleum on the Richland County Gathering System (cancels FERC No. 4.18.0); and
- FERC Tariff No. 5.44.0, Proportional Tariff applying on the gathering / transportation of crude petroleum on the Market Center Gathering System (cancels FERC No. 5.43.0)

Hiland is making this filing to revise FERC Tariff No. 2.22.0, reflecting a clarification to the nomination timeline and Hiland's ability to reject on a not unduly discriminatory basis certain qualities of crude oil shipments. FERC Tariff No. 4.19.0 Richland County Gathering System removes the Albin Station location as it is no longer operationally available to receive or deliver crude petroleum products. Also, FERC Tariff No. 5.44.0 expands the definition of the origin areas for West Camp Creek and Bainville to include new sections.
