Re: - Advice Letter No. 53-O of SFPP, L.P. (PLC-9); Compliance with Decision No. 14-12-057

Dear ED Tariff Unit:

SFPP, L.P. ("SFPP") hereby submits its Advice Letter No. 53-O as a Tier 2 filing in compliance with Commission Decision No. 14-12-057 that was issued with an effective date of December 18, 2014. This annual filing is to be effective January 1, 2025.

- Tariff Cal PUC No. 155 North System (cancelling Cal CPUC No. 153) new transportation rate.
- Tariff Cal PUC No. 156 South System (cancelling Cal CPUC No. 154) new transportation rate.

Decision No. 14-12-057 adopted a comprehensive settlement of all pending Commission rate applications and complaints at the time involving SFPP's California pipeline operations and related rates, including consolidated proceedings docketed as C. 97-04-025 et al. With the settlement approved by D. 14-12-057 SFPP filed to established a surcharge on January 1, 2015, to recover over a period of ten (10) years SFPP's increased Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way ("ROW") expense related to pending litigation, with a cap of \$45 million on the amount of supplemental ROW costs that SFPP is entitled to recover over the ten-year period. The previous ROW surcharge update went into effect on October 1, 2017 reflecting the final resolution with the UPRR.

In compliance with D. 14-12-057, SFPP hereby submits the following revisions to its tariffs, effective January 1, 2025:

(1) Tariffs Cal PUC 155 and 156 in Attachments A and B reflect the removal of the surcharge at all locations, which in turn decreases the total transportation rates for each destination shown.

SFPP is providing a copy of this advice letter to its shippers of record (See Attachment C hereto) in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 96-B. A copy of the required Tariff Summary Sheet is included in Attachment D.




Item 40. Minimum Tender and Delivery Requirements

- 40.1 The minimum quantity of any one Petroleum Product of like specification from one shipper which will be accepted shall be 5,000 Barrels.
- 40.2 The minimum quantity which shall be delivered at any destination station shall be 2,500 Barrels.
- 40.3 The minimum quantity of diesel fuel accepted from any point on the Benicia to Richmond pipeline is 10,000 barrels and must be preceded and followed by a minimum 5,000 barrel non-diesel batch from the origin to the destination, the sum of which is delivered to a single delivery point.






